Policy Document

Selection Criteria for ISU Sanctioned International Competitions

Issued 17th November 2006

1. General Information

SISA will endeavor to nominate skaters to ISU Sanctioned International Competitions whenever an invitation from an ISU Member Nation is received.

The SISA Selection Panel shall determine the skaters that will compete at ISU competitions based on the criterion drawn up.

2. General Eligibility

To be eligible for selection each skater must:

- be a member, in good standing, of the Singapore Ice Skating Association
- compete at the National Championships
- be able to commit to a regular training program
- be able to travel to international competition in the months following selection
- sign a Notice of Intent form that must be submitted to SISA by 29th February 2008
- be prepared to sign an athlete agreement form if selected

3. Notice of Intent

Skaters that wish to be considered for selection must complete and return a notice of intent form prior to the due date of 29th February 2008. Failure to do so will render the skater ineligible for selection.

4. Selection

- Selection will be based primarily on the skater's performance at the Singapore National Championships.
- Consideration will also be given to a skater's performance in any other eligible event. Eligible events include any domestic or international competition where an ISU approved judging system is used.
- Prospective skaters must compete in the Singapore National Championships unless exempted in writing in advance by the Selection Panel.
- The Selection Panel will consider the overall performance of the skater from his/her competition record (eligible events only) and whether his/her potential standard is suitable for participation in the designated ISU International Competition.

- SISA reserves the right not to nominate a skater to an ISU International Competition if, in its sole opinion, the skater concerned cannot meet the performance targets set by SISA.

5. Alternate Team Members

- In addition to the selected skater for each ISU International Competition, SISA may nominate an alternate skater.
- In the event that the selected skater is unable to attend the competition for whatever reason, SISA reserves the right to nominate the alternate at its sole discretion.

6. Athlete Agreement

Each skater will be required to sign an athlete agreement form with SISA listing responsibilities and requisite behaviours of the athlete leading up to and including the designated ISU International Competition.

A closing date for return of the signed agreement will be specified and will pre-date commencement of the designated ISU International Competition.

7. Process of Appeals

Skaters who wish to appeal will have to write to the Selection Panel within 5 days of the announcement of the athlete selection. SISA reserves the right to interpret this document and to use its sole discretion in the resolving of the matter in conflict or dispute.

The Selection Panel will consider all appeals and submit accordingly to the Appeals Committee.

Athletes may, thereafter, continue to appeal to SSC in writing. SISA will discuss with SSC if necessary. However, all entries to ISU International Competitions must be endorsed by SISA.
