The Singapore Ice Skating Association has once again been invited by the Singapore National Olympic Council and the Gangwon Provincial Government, Korea to participate in the Korean Dream Program. The Korean hosts have specified that Singapore may send three participating skaters who must be born between 1994 and 1998. They must also be a Singapore citizen or PR.

The Korean Dream Program is set up by the Korean Olympic Committee to introduce winter sports to countries that would not normally have the opportunity to take part in these sports. The program will run from 1 – 10 February 2010.

There will be 140 participants from 35 countries. The sports that they will introduce are skiing, snowboarding, speed skating, short track speed skating and figure skating. Criteria for selection:

- This program is only open to the following members:
  - a) 1 place offered to all SISA members
  - a) 2 places offered to the National and Development Team members.
- Interested skaters must opt in by Singapore time 12:00 hour Thursday, 19 November 2009, by submitting their names via email to the SISA Administration Officer [administration@sisa.org.sg](mailto:administration@sisa.org.sg).
- Interested skaters must have a valid passport.
- Participants will be selected through a random draw.
- Successful applicants will be notified immediately after the draw.
- All selected skaters must sign the SISA Code of Ethics as well as a Code of Ethics provided by the host country. Skaters will be representing Singapore; any misbehaviour will be dealt with by SISA in consultation with SSC and SNOG.
- Selected skaters and one parent must make themselves available to attend a briefing and commit to submitting all necessary documents and duly completed application forms as required by our Korean hosts, latest by Monday 30 November 2009. Time and venue of briefing to be advised.
