ISU CHAMPIONSHIP NOMINATION CRITERIA

Overview

This Policy establishes the criteria for nomination to ISU Championship Events for the season commencing July 1st 2009, and ending on the 31st March 2010.

Four Continents

Nominations for the 2010 ISU Four Continents Championships shall be determined by the results at the 2009 Singapore National Figure Skating Championships (SNFSC).

Skater Selection – Singles

1. Senior age eligible skaters with the highest total point scores obtained at the 2009 SFSC in Senior or Junior events shall be eligible for nomination.
2. A nominated skater must have competed at one or more Senior or Junior international competitions in the 24 months preceding the 2010 ISU Four Continents Championships.
3. The number of skaters nominated shall be as determined by the ISU.

Subsequently ranked skaters shall be nominated as substitutes.

Athletes nominated for the 2010 ISU Four Continents Championships must notify the Administration Coordinator by the due date of their acceptance of their nomination.

Should injury or illness prevent any skater from competing at the 2009 SNFSC they may apply for exceptional circumstances according to the SISA Procedure – 120 Medical Notification and Clearance Procedure. They may then be considered for the Four Continents Championships as described below.

Exceptional Circumstances – Four Continents

Any skater who is unable to compete at the 2009 SNFSC must apply for an exceptional circumstance in order to be considered for the 2009 ISU Four Continents Championships.

Having satisfied all conditions outlined in the SISA Procedure – 120 Medical notification and Clearance Procedure, the skater may be eligible for exceptional circumstance consideration. If consideration is granted, the skater is required to compete in an international event (Junior or Senior) prior to 1st December 2009.

The Total Score achieved at the international event will be used to rank the skater compared to athletes who competed in the Senior Division at the 2009 SFSC. The Total Score may also be analysed further (considering the Total Element Scores) to determine the final ranking for nomination to the 2009 ISU Four Continents Championships.

World Championships

Nominations for the 2010 ISU World Figure Skating Championships shall be determined as follows:

Minimum Criteria – Singles

Any skater nominated must achieve a minimum Total Segment Score for the Short Program of 35.00 in at least one of the following events, to be eligible for a World nomination:

- a. ISU Junior Grand Prix Competitions or International Senior Competitions in the 2009-2010 season
- b. 2009 ISU Four Continents Championship

Skater Selection – Singles

1. The skater with the highest Total Point Score (sum of the Total Segment Score in both the Short and Free Skating Programs) at the 2010 ISU Four Continents Championships shall be nominated provided that they meet the minimum criteria as stated.

Subsequently ranked skaters (as determined by either 1 or 2 above) shall be nominated as substitutes, providing they meet the minimum criteria as outlined.

Athletes nominated for the 2010 ISU World Figure Skating Championships must notify the Administration Coordinator by the due date of their acceptance of their nomination.

Junior World Championships

Nominations for the 2010 ISU World Junior Figure Skating Championships shall be determined as follows:

Minimum Criteria – Singles

All skaters must achieve a minimum Total Point Score of 70.00 in at least one of the following events, to be eligible for a Junior World nomination:

- a. ISU Junior Grand Prix Competitions in the 2009-2010 season
- b. Other Junior International Level Competition, as endorsed by the International Selection Committee

Skater Selection – Singles

1. The skater with the highest Total Point Scores (is the sun of the Total Segment Score in both the Short and Free Skating programs) from the 2009/2010 Junior Grand Prix competitions shall be nominated.

Subsequently ranked skaters (as determined by either 1 or 2 above) shall be nominated as substitutes, providing they meet the minimum criteria as outlined.

Athletes nominated for the 2010 ISU World Junior Figure Skating Championships must notify the Administration Coordinator by the due date of their acceptance of their nomination.

Decisions of Singapore Ice Skating Association

All decisions of Singapore Ice Skating Association relating to nomination to ISU Championship events are final.
